A four-day course, entitled 'The Kidney as an Endocrine Organ', will be held at the University of Warwick on March 18-21, 2014.

The course will provide a comprehensive insight into the role of the kidney as an endocrine organ. It will also introduce the basic physiology of the main endocrine functions of the kidney and clinical conditions associated with abnormal function, including hypertension, diabetes mellitus and chronic kidney disease. These two elements are integrated throughout the course, particularly during the small group work.
